### Requirementsforpaperexecution

Papers are to be submitted in a ready-to-print form. The text file is to be in .rtf format, up to two A4 pages including figures and reference list. All margins are to be 2.5 cm each. Font – Times New Roman, font size – 12. The headline of the report (in semi-bold upper case) is to be aligned to the center, followed by last names and initials of contributors aligned to the right with line spacing 1.5. Begin a new line with the name of institution, location, e-mail address with line spacing 1.5, followed by the abovementioned information in English with line spacing 1.5. The body of the text begins with an indent 2.0 (line spacing 1.0, paragraph 1 cm, with automatic hyphenation; no headers, footers and page numbers; with full text justification). The following empty line is followed by the new line with the word Literature aligned to the center. The next new line begins with the reference list in alphabetical order, in-text references are to be given in square brackets [last name, year]. Figures and tables are not to exceed the size of 15x15 cm as .jpg file with resolution 300 dpi min., and to be submitted in a file attachment different from a main one.
